

2012 Summer School Timetable - Flexible Delivery

Dates

The 2012 Flexible Delivery Summer School commences on Monday 9th January and runs for 6 weeks until Sunday 19th February.

Workload and maximum enrolment

Summer School is six weeks in duration. This means that students will study at double the normal pace of a 12 week term. Students should ensure that they have adequate time set aside each week to commit to the work required of the course (15 hours per week, per unit). It is recommended that Students enroll in 1 unit only, however Students may enroll in a maximum of 2 concurrent units over Summer School.
